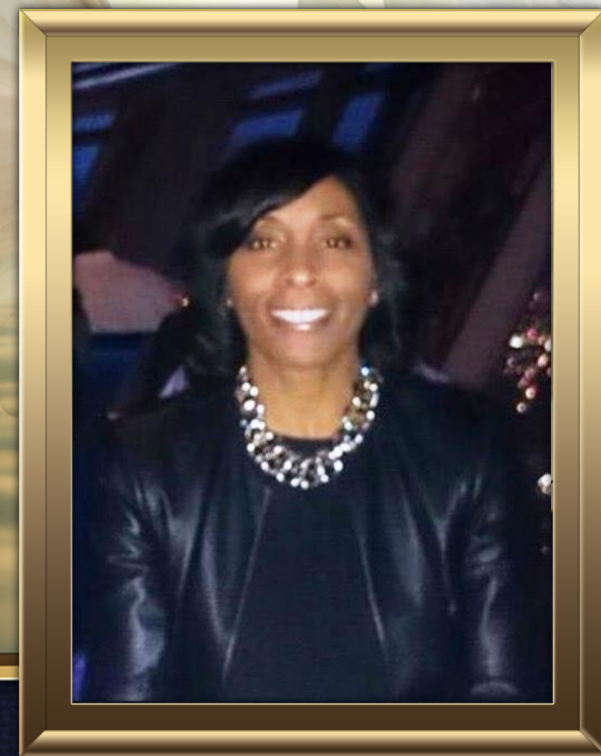

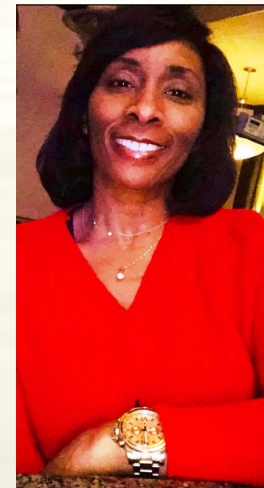
She loved spending time with her children and grandchildren; making memories and traditions were very important to her.
