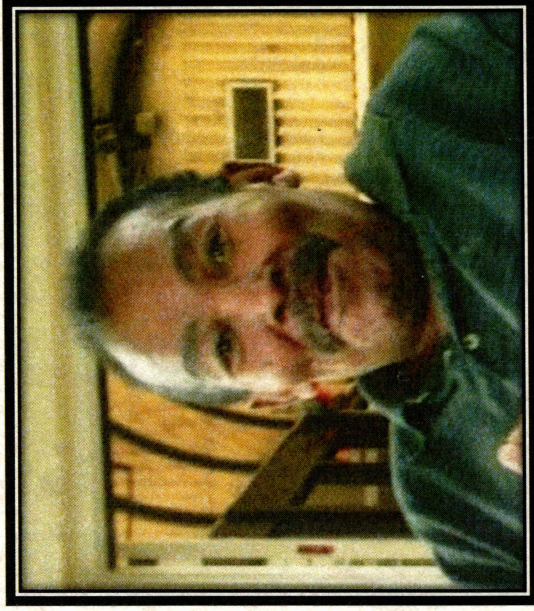
Recessional

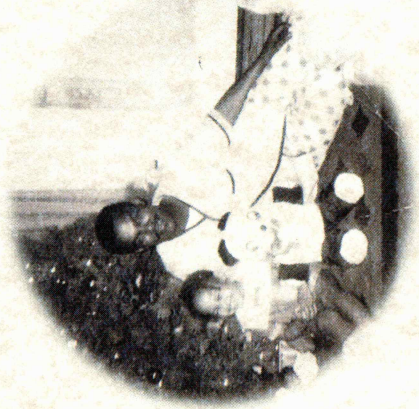
